

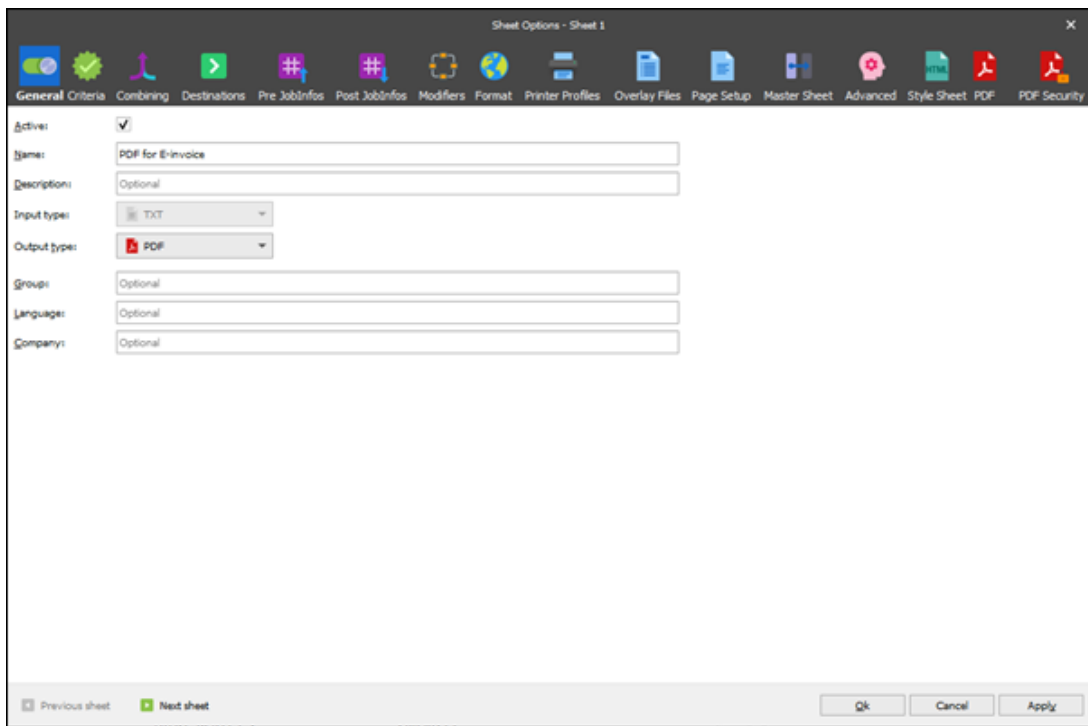

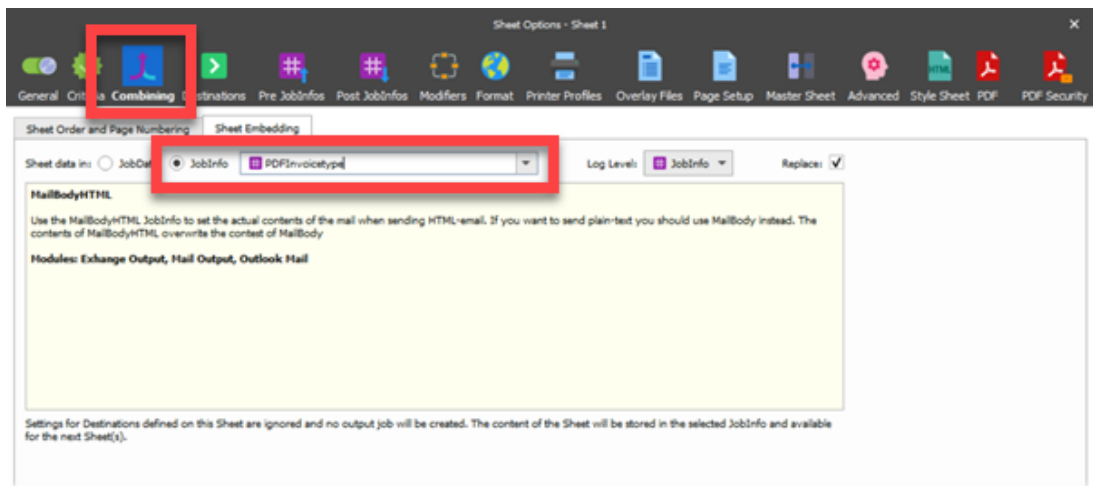
To embed a Base-64 encoded PDF sheet into an XML file, follow these steps:

1. Create a PDF sheet and place it before an XML sheet.



2. Within the *Sheet options* window, select the **Combining** option and then click the **Sheet Embedding** tab.

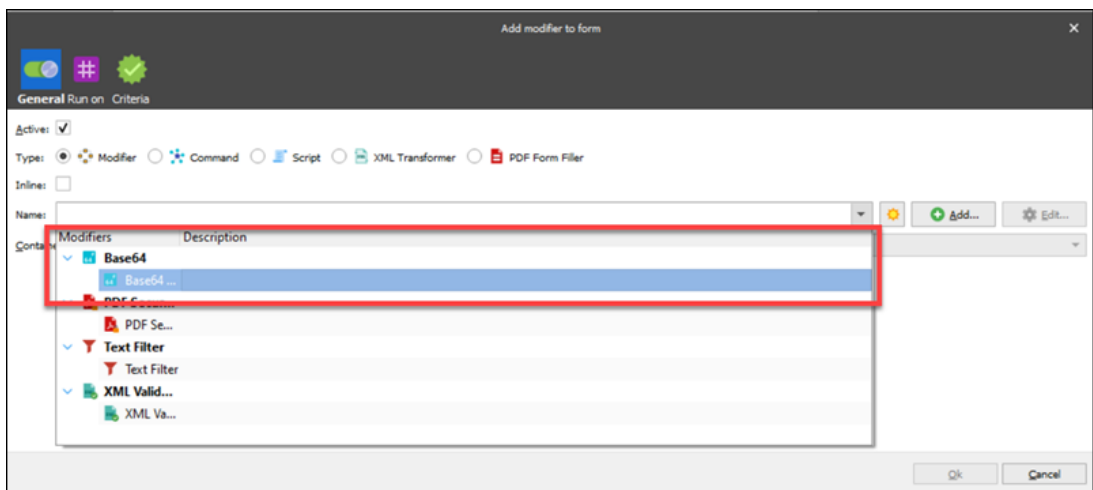
3. Select the **JobInfo** radio button and then type in a name for the document and click **Ok**. In the example, we see 'PDFInvoicetype'.

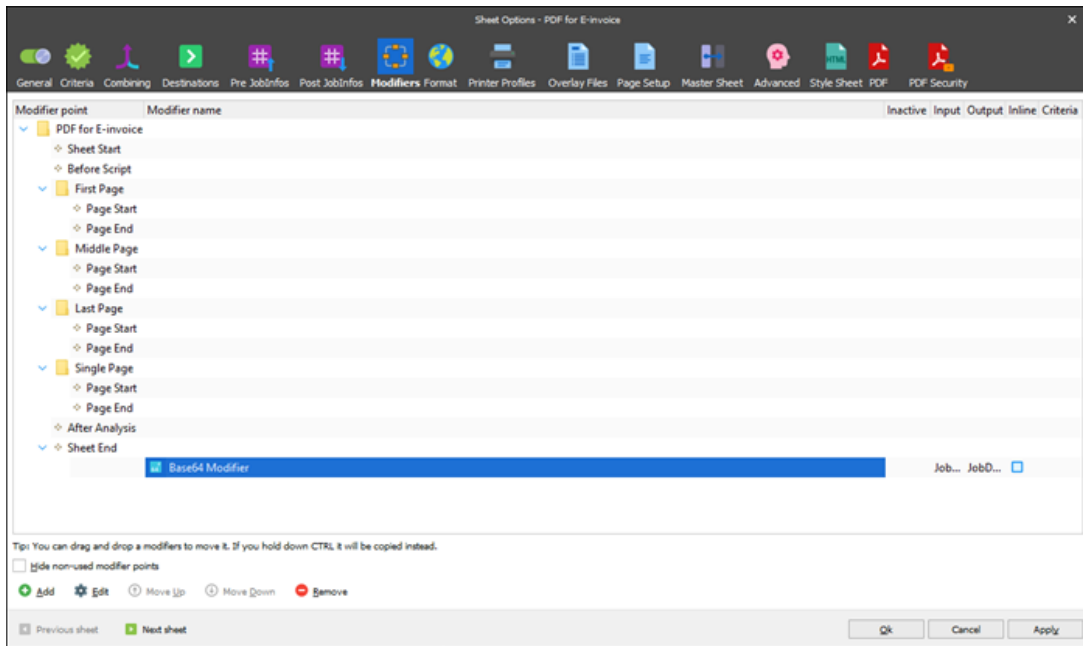


4. On *Sheet Options*, click **Modifiers**, right-click **Sheet End** and select **Add** from the pop-up menu.

The *Add modifier to form* window is displayed.

5. On the *Name* drop-down menu, select **Base64** and click **Ok**.





6. On the XML Sheet, insert the data into an element using the Insert Text option - type of Insert text: JobInfo.
